



Auxiliary Emergency Fund (AEF)

The Auxiliary Emergency Fund (AEF) is a national grant assistance program that provides temporary emergency assistance to eligible members of the American Legion Auxiliary up to \$2400 as the result of an act of nature or another personal crisis. Grant funds may be used only for shelter or utilities. Only members of the American whose dues are current and who have maintained membership for three consecutive years (the current year and immediate past two years) are eligible to apply.
